Last week it was the **Bluebell Class** assembly. The children retold the events of the Great Fire of London and sang London's Burning with their own unique twist! We heard about how fantastic their History Off the Page day was and saw pictures of the children dressed up and taking part in all of the different activities. Finally, the children shared pictures of when local firefighters visited school and recited a poem. It was a lovely way to end the children's learning about the Great Fire of London!

On Wednesday **Holly Class** produced a fabulous assembly all about Space! They were able to explain all about the Solar System, Planets, Earth's Axis, Constellations and Exploration. Some of them even walked on the Moon! Well done Holly Class!



British Sign Language Assembly

This Tuesday KS2 were treated to an extra special assembly arising from our language of the term, British Sign Language. Three children from the special unit within East Hunsbury Primary School, Matthew, Sophie and Harry visited us to show us the simplified version, Makaton, which is an alternative way of signing. They all gave different reasons for signing from using it with friends, at the end of the day and being too tired to talk, to using it regularly to communicate. The children then treated us to a song, True Colours, which they signed. There was a spontaneous reaction from many children joining in with the signing and warm, appreciative applause from the whole hall. Sarah Halsall, their teacher, explained how Makaton is used every day in their school. Finally, Christmas came early and we all learnt how to

sign to the song 'Must be Santa' which was lots of fun. Our children have referred to the assembly as 'an amazing experience, fantastic, incredible' and, signing, have given it a big thumbs up!



On Friday 6th October, **Oak class** held their assembly. They started off by demonstrating the Haka, and then we were taken on a journey through the Battle of Britain, using role play, diaries and poetry. We learnt about how shadows change in relation to a light source, and ended up with a Maths quiz. A big thank you to the parents and children who completed the challenge we set you!

For the second week in row KS1 attendance winners are Buttercup class, with an unbeatable 100%. In second place are Violet class with 99.3% attendance. In joint third are Daisy and Snowdrop classes, with 97%.

KS2 Attendance winners this week are Thistle class with an impressive 99.6% attendance. Tulip class came second with 99.3%, closely followed by Holly with 99.2%.
