Dear parents and carers,

A warm (despite the continued chilly weather!) welcome back to EBPS for the summer term. The children have settled wonderfully back into learning this week and all staff have commented on the children's calm behaviour and focused learning as they embrace their new topics. The summer term is a busy one with exciting learning, trips, residentials for Y3 and Y6, SATs (for Y6) and quizzes (for Y2) and transition arrangements to prepare the children for their new year group in September.

We continue to use the Empowerment Approach to support teaching children about their brain and behaviour and developing in children the skills they need to be pro-social and pro-learning individuals who achieve well and enjoy their time in school. We have refined this and introduced a Friday afternoon "Excellence in Everything" reward playtime for children in Years Two – Six who have shown excellence in the vast majority of lessons during the week. Children who have disturbed learning or needed lots of reminders, will have some time on a Friday afternoon with their teacher or a senior leader discussing their behaviour and how we can help them ensure they are Ready, Respectful and Safe in all lessons. Children will have a tick grid that shows where they have been successful or needed reminders and this will be sent home with your child each Friday.

# **Reading**

## <u>Uniform</u>

Thank you to the vast majority of parents /carers and children who support and uphold our school uniform policy. A reminder to the minority that children should not wear any jewellery at all on PE days (earrings must be removed, they cannot be taped). On other days, children may wear one stud earring in each ear and a watch – no other jewellery should be in school.
