

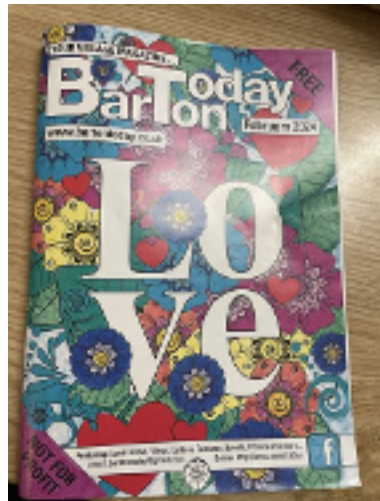


A brilliant start to the year with a two day workshop from the Word Guerilla! He taught the children to use spoken word to produce a rap about our school values.

Our incredible tag rugby team came in 4th place in the county finals at Kettering Rugby Club! A superb achievement as they only lost one match!

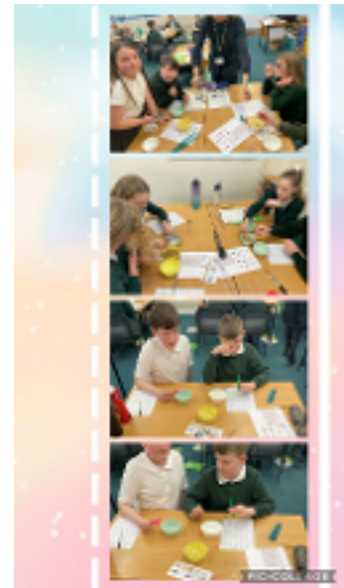
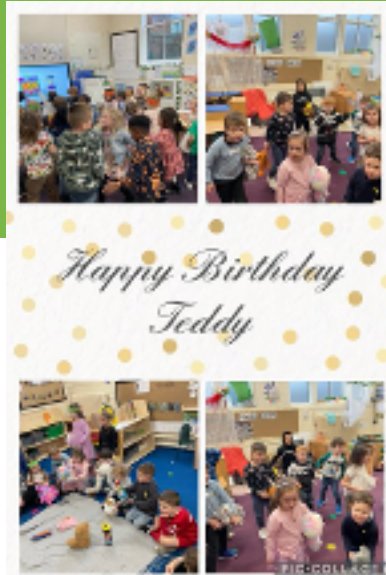
