Children in EYFS had a brilliant fossil excavation workshop! The children made us proud by listening so carefully to our expert and uncovering a variety of different fossils and bones using the correct tools!

Year 6 had Sam from Wrenn School come in to deliver a workshop all about how light works. It allowed the children both to reinforce what they have learned in the classroom and to extend their understanding!
