Our music performance assembly meant we were able to enjoy some music from children in the school currently learning to play instrumentals - they were fantastic!

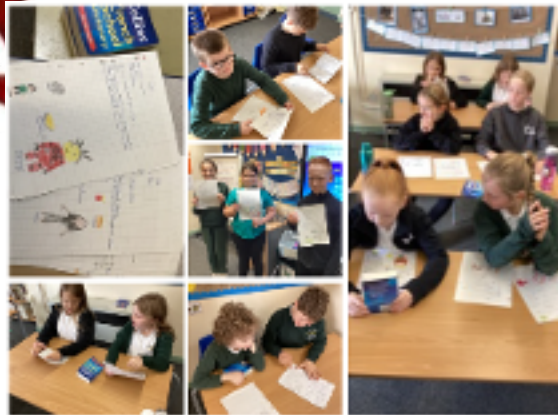


We had an outstanding turnout for our 'Pie and a Poem' event in the Key Stage 1 hall - thank you to Mrs Warren for organising!
