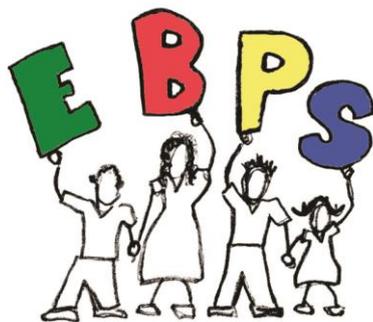
Dear Parents/carers,
