Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic this term, 'Illuminate and Celebrate' we will be learning about the Great Fire of London. As a way of providing your child with the best opportunity to find out more about the Great Fire of London, we have arranged for History Off the Page to spend the day with us on Tuesday 3rd October and Thursday 5th October.

Bluebell, Crocus and Primrose classes will be on Tuesday 3rd October
Snowdrop and Violet classes will be on Thursday 5th October

On this day, your child will use practical activities and drama to find out what it was like living through the Great Fire. During the afternoon, the children will have investigated and found out about a specific job and family living in London in 1666. There will also be a story-telling session. Children are to wear a simple, inexpensive costume to help them feel part of the day.

Costumes can include, a large plain shirt with a belt or cord round the waist, plain waistcoat and plain, dark, baggy trousers (such as track-suit bottoms) to tuck into long socks. A long, plain skirt, an apron - preferably plain white, you could attach a rectangle of white material to a tie (no gathers or pockets), a coif - (for your head), a triangle of white material tied around the head to hide the hair. The long ends are tied over the hanging point, which is then tucked over the knot.

We need a number of adult helpers, so please join us and you will see for yourself the value of the day! The voluntary contribution to cover the cost for the day is £5.00. For children in receipt of the Pupil Premium allowance it will be presumed, unless the school office is informed otherwise, that payment for school trips will automatically be taken from their child's allowance.
