



Spelling Homework – Spelling Shed

Information for parents

Great news! At Earls Barton Primary School we would like your child to use the Spelling Shed system as part of their school work.

The Spelling Shed helps children to practise spelling via a simple game. The game gives four different degrees of support in the form of difficulty modes: Easy, Medium, Hard and Extreme. Higher levels allow a higher score to be achieved but children can practise as much as they like on lower levels before trying to gain high scores. The scores achieved give a league position and each class has its own league position within a school league. Spelling Shed also allows for homework and whole-class “Hive” games as a more interactive form of a spelling test.

In order to access Spelling Shed your child will need a unique username & password which has been created by the school. The Username is your child’s full first name, followed by the first letter of their surname and then EBPri – without any spaces. Please note that it is case sensitive. The password is spelling. Therefore, the login for the name Joe Bloggs would become:

Username: JoeBEBPri

Password: spelling

Once your child has successfully logged in to <https://spellingshed.com> they can access the online game via <https://play.spellingshed.com>.

Please be aware that we have some duplicate names and first initials within the school however if your child’s login is different then you will have been notified by the school.

An assignment has been created for each year group which your child can access to practice some of the rules that they will have learnt at school along with the common exception words from their phase. If your child wants to practice other words then the stages shown on Spelling Shed correspond to their year group i.e. Stage 1 = Year 1.
