**Red Nose Day
Friday 15th March 2019**

Red Nose Day 2019 is just around the corner and we've decided to join in the fun.

To raise money, we're going to sell red noses at school in the run up to Red Nose Day. Red Noses will be on sale at break time for £1.25 from Monday 4th March. EYFS and KS1 children will be able to buy a red nose from their hall and KS2 children will be able to buy theirs from Cool Kids Corner. Where possible, please send your child into school with the correct change.

In addition to this, pupils were asked by their school council reps to come up with some fundraising ideas. We have decided to go with the most popular ones:

- On Friday 15th March all children can come to school dressed in RED for a contribution of £1.
- EYFS and KS1 children wanted to hold a bring and buy toy sale. Any contributions for the toy sale (which can come from children across the whole school) should be brought in on Friday 15th March. Children in EYFS and KS1 can also bring in a maximum of £1 (in addition to the £1 for wearing red) to buy something from the toy sale which will be held in the EYFS and KS1 hall during the afternoon. Toys will be priced up to a maximum of £1.
- KS2 children wanted a board games afternoon. For a contribution of £1 (in addition to the £1 for wearing red) KS2 children can bring in games from home to play with their friends in the afternoon. Children must not bring electronics of any kind. We have some board games in school which children will be able to play with as well.

The money we raise will be used to change countless lives, both here in the UK and worldwide.

In fact, just £3 could pay for crayons, pencils, paint and paper for children living in a Serbian refugee camp. And £10 could cover the cost of 10 hot meals for a homeless person in the UK.

We'll also be using Red Nose Day as a learning opportunity to help our pupils explore the issues facing young people across the world, and how the money we raise can help.

We really appreciate your support and hope that the children will have fun helping us raise lots of money for Red Nose Day.
