Advance notice and information for September:

- Our parent forum asked us to reconsider our timings for the end of the school day. As a result these will be changing from September so that the EYFS and key stage one children finish first at 3.25pm with key stage two exiting at 3.30pm. There will also be an aligning of the lunchtime so that lunch will be from 12 noon until 1pm in both buildings.
- Having taken feedback from parents and staff regarding the class structure from September we have made the professional decision to have only one mixed class in key stage one and one mixed class in lower key stage two. Senior leaders are in the process of setting the classes taking into account all that they and the staff know about the children both academically and socially. Children and parents will be notified which class their child is going to be in and who their teacher is on Monday 2 July.
- We are excited to have new staff starting with us in September - Mr Passby and Miss Bartholomew in key stage two and Mrs Taylor in key stage one.
- Children across the whole school will **not** be allowed to bring any items in from home to play with at break times - extra equipment is made available by the school to keep children occupied.

In key stage two children provide their own snack for morning break if wished but please remember this should be a portion of fruit or vegetable as we are encouraging healthy eating. In EYFS and key stage one this snack will still be provided as part of the government scheme.
