Have your circumstances changed?

We are very aware that during these challenging times a lot of our families circumstances may have changed. There may be more children who are now eligible for Free School Meals. If you feel you may now be eligible to apply, please do so at

You will need to have your National Security Number to hand. If your family qualifies, then vouchers are available to help during school closure periods. Additionally, when school re-starts, there will be a personal allowance for each eligible child for families to spend supporting their child's education.

Calling all budding musicians!!

Learning a musical instrument is a fantastic skill. It gives hours of pleasure and is with you for life. As someone who plays several instruments, I firmly believe that this has been an absolute bonus during the difficult times of lockdown! The earlier you start learning, the better!

Here at EBPS, instrumental teachers from Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust visit our school on a weekly basis to offer tuition in several instruments.

NMPAT offer :-

Strings (violin etc) from Year 2 upwards

Brass, woodwind, keyboard and guitar from Year 3 upwards.

Instrumental lessons are weekly and in school time. With the exception of guitar, instruments are loaned from the music trust.

If you would be interested in your child learning an instrument, you need to arrange payment with NMPAT directly. They then contact the school to give us a list of children and a lesson timetable. Lessons can be arranged by registering on NMPAT website.:


