

Use your imagination and enjoy yourself. You can be as silly as you like!







Have your circumstances changed?

We are very aware that during these challenging times a lot of our families circumstances may have changed. There may be more children who are now eligible for Free School Meals. If you feel you may now be eligible to apply, please do so at <https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals/northamptonshire>. You will need to have your National Security Number to hand. If your family qualifies, then vouchers are available to help during school closure periods. Additionally, when school re-starts, there will be a personal allowance for each eligible child for families to spend supporting their child's education.


