Dear parents and carers,

Another reminder that our whole school sports day will be held on the Earls Barton rec. On Thursday 7th July. Please bring children to school as normal and then make your way to the rec. We aim to start the events by 9:30am once we have registered all children and walked them safely to the rec.

A couple of other points:

- Children will be competing in mixed age (Reception – Year 6 Commonwealth country) groups and siblings will be together. Each Commonwealth country is aiming to earn as many points as possible!
- Children should wear normal PE kit (white t-shirt and black or green shorts)
- Parents / carers who are spectating may wish to bring their own chair
- The Earls Barton youth club are kindly allowing us to use their facilities for toilets and first aid
- There will be a paper programme available nearer the time to show the order of events
- There will be a rotation of sporting events covering all aspects of athletics and the finishing races will be sprint finals (the heats will have been run in PE lessons)

-On this day, we will have a whole school “picnic lunch” back at school rather than hot lunches due to the logistics involved in getting 470 children and staff off-site and back by 12 noon! Kingswood are aware and all school lunch orders will be a sandwich option OR children can bring a packed lunch from home.

-The winning country team will be awarded a medal the next day in school assembly (to allow us to add up all scores!)

-The winner of each running race final will also be awarded a medal

-We are being supported on this day by Wollaston secondary school young sports leaders

-We would welcome parent volunteers to help with road crossing and a final safety check / litter pick of the rec before the events start (staff will also do this at 8am)

-We would like to use four gazebos on the day for shade in four rest stations – if you have one we could borrow for the day, please let the office know
